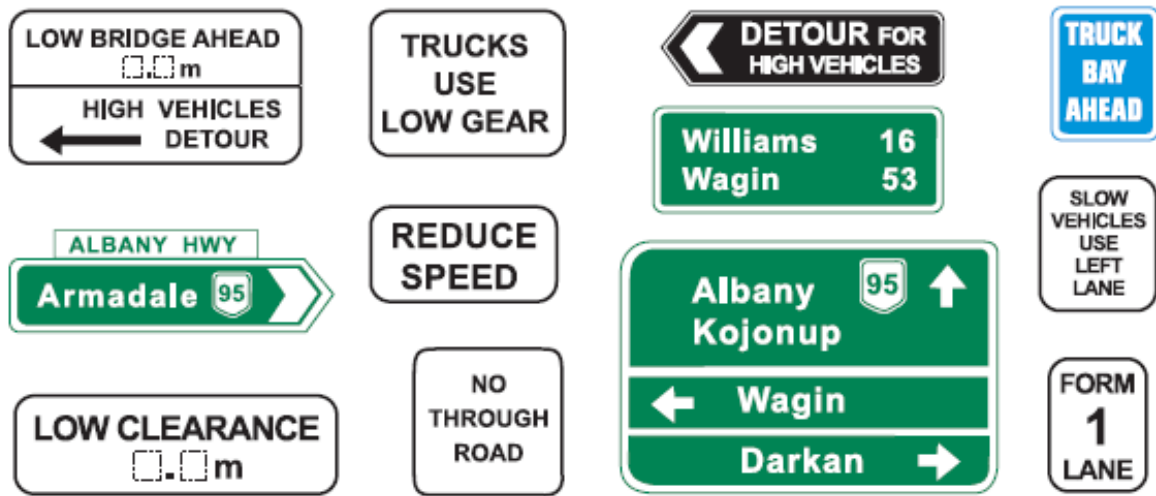
- **Regulatory Signs** – used to control traffic



- **Warning Signs** – used to alert road users of possible dangers ahead (generally yellow and black in colour or red-orange for pedestrian warning signs)



- **Guide Signs** – used to give directions, distances, routes and road user information



- **Signs and Devices for Road Works and Special Purposes** – used to warn road users about temporary hazards
